Today, climate change is challenging our world of coffee

Predictions: rising coffee demand of 2.5%/year¹ yield losses 0.25%/year, land area losses 0.46%/year due to climate change¹ A total of 50% reduction in suitable coffee-growing areas²





Will we be able to meet the global coffee demand?

- Shifting cultivation to higher altitudes / different places <-> EUDR³
- Sustainable coffee production / shade trees / intercropping
- Development of climate-resilient coffee varieties <-> time intensive

If not, what else do we drink?

Coffee alternatives and substitutes

- Expected market growth USD 17 billion/2025 to USD 23 billion/2030^{4,5}
- Fruits, seeds, cereals, roots, other plant materials; ± caffeine
- processing similar to coffee: harvest, clean, sort, dry, roast, grind, extract

Handling coffee alternatives and substitutes in household devices

- Grinding: acorns are too big
- Extraction: coarser grind size required; smaller amount of powder; swelling; pulsed extraction reduces sieve clogging
- Sensory: acorn+coffee promising; chicory with oat milk yummy;
 lupines with barley malt: coffee like, sweet, nutty, chocolate, well balanced
- Quality: freshness, origin, processing
- Crema: very little and not stable (due to freshness?)
- Health: might contain toxins; acorns tannic acid; lupines alkaloides

- Are we ready for a journey to innovative products of coffee substitutes and alternatives, be it ready-to-drink, encapsulated or freshly ground and freshly prepared?
