The scientific program contains two parts:

- 1-A Half-day industry-sponsored Workshop: 'Innate immunity in the pathophysiology of autoinflammatory diseases' aimed to gather experiences on new treatment targets, biomarkers, data repositories, outcome measures, and integrated research strategies;
- 2-Two-day main meeting aimed to update on clinical innovations, recommendations, basic science, and to give the opportunity sharing clinical experiences. The mains topics will include epidemiology, genetics, pathogenesis, diagnosis, risk factors, management, cardiac complications, and outcome. Sessions will also be dedicated to interactive presentation of difficult cases and best oral communications.

This program will offer the opportunity to discuss both scientifically and technically. The organizing committee expects to welcome between 350 and 450 participants from all over the world, researchers, students, clinicians and practitioners as well as professionals of the health industry.
